SCOAPE Outlook: May 11, 2019 (Today) & May 12, 2019 (Sunday)

- Moisture & quasi-stationary front will aid in producing showers & thunderstorms along front from Western Gulf to parts of Mid-Atlantic & into Southeast through Monday.
- As western end of front slowly moves eastward showers & thunderstorms will end by Sunday evening into Monday.
- A window for opportunity for column NO₂ validation may develop Today in the afternoon hours into early daytime Sunday before front finally moves east towards Petronius.
- Current track has Point Sur moving southwest towards Thunderhorse at this point.



Saturday (5/11) and Sunday (5/12): A quasi-stationary front extending from Mid-Atlantic southwestward to Lower Mississippi through Sunday evening & moisture moving northward out of GOM will pool along boundary. The moisture & front will aid in producing showers & thunderstorms along front from Western Gulf to parts of Mid-Atlantic & into Southeast through Monday. As western end of front slowly moves eastward showers & thunderstorms will end over by Sunday evening into Monday.

In Cocodrie Today: Showers & thunderstorms likely, mainly after 4pm. Mostly cloudy, with high 82. Southeast wind 10-15 mph. Chance of precipitation is 60%.

In Cocodrie Sunday: Showers & thunderstorms likely, mainly before 8am. Mostly cloudy, then gradually becoming sunny, with high 82. Southwest wind 10-15 mph, with gusts as high as 30 mph. Chance of precipitation is 60%.




Today, Saturday, May 11, 2019: Most of the heavy rain/thunderstorms stays to west of Heavy Emissions Area (east of LOOP) until late Saturday when chance of precipitation increases.


Tomorrow, Sunday, May 12, 2019: Stalled front moves east: Rain/Thunderstorms likely along LA coast. Moving east to Petronius and deepwater platforms offshore is still best option.

Tomorrow NAM 10am CDT Forecast




GEOS Cloud Cover and Precipitation for Today (5/11)



- GFS Cloud Cover for Today, Saturday, May 11: Suggests similar to GEOS that there will be possible breaks in clouds today by afternoon.
- May be clear for ozonesonde launch if southerly winds and sea calm.
